All voters should bring proof of identification showing name and address. For a list of acceptable forms of ID, visit: http://www.mah.gov.on.ca/Page18734.aspx#identification.

Failing that, you can also sign a legal declaration form at the voting place that confirms your voting eligibility (that you are a Canadian citizen, over the age of 18, and currently reside in the City of Waterloo).


## **Great Turnout at Boston** Pizza Fun-Raiser
